# **Assisted Living**

Forest Hills of DC offers Assisted Living services to our residents upon entry or as the need arises. Routine Assisted Living services are provided to residents in their own apartment and do not require relocation.

Assisted Living is defined as the intermittent assistance of one person, but not total dependence with Activities of Daily Living.

Activities of Daily Living are: Assistance with medications, dressing, bathing, grooming, bathroom use or incontinent care, cueing or redirecting, and escorts to and from meals or social and fitness activities.

Upon admission, we will work with a resident's physician and our Registered Nurse will meet with a resident and their family member to determine the appropriate Level of Care.

Our Levels of Care are based on amount and complexity of assistance needed.

#### Forest Hills of DC Levels of Care are as follows:

Levell	Basic Care	\$790 per month
Level II	Enhanced Care	\$1,580 per month
Level III	Advanced Care*	\$2,370 per month
Level IV	Maximum Care*	\$4,000 per month

<sup>\*</sup>Level III Advanced Care and Level IV Maximum Care may require placement in a designated assisted living unit.

Pre-admission estimated Level of Care is subject to change at thirty (30) day post admission assessment.

Level of Care fees do not include personal consumable supplies (e.g. incontinence products).



#### Health Care Center

The most concentrated of our health care areas at Forest Hills of DC is our Health Care Center offering skilled nursing in short-term rehabilitation and long-term care.

Short-term rehabilitation is ideal for any resident who requires recovery from postsurgical or post-hospital stays with the goal of returning to their previous home or to one of our community apartments. We offer full rehabilitation services on-site in our expansive and state of the art rehabilitation department.

Our Rehabilitation Department provides Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, and Speech Therapy to address a variety of restorative or physical maintenance challenges.

There is a daily exercise program that is collaboration between our Activity and Therapy Departments that allows all residents who are interested to partake in a seated exercise program. The classes are run by our Activity Department and are held in the Health Care Center Day Room.

Long-term care provides skilled nurses to assist our residents throughout their days and nights in activities of daily living.

While in our Health Care Center the social, spiritual and physical aspects of our care are complimented with the philosophy of providing the best quality of life for all of our residents.
