Therapists can also perform an evaluation of your home for safety issues and make recommendations for any adaptations.

You'll have access to all Forest Hills' amenities, including:

- Prioritization given to transplant patients for private suites

You will continue your transplant immunosuppression medication regimen and follow-ups as scheduled while you receive physical rehabilitation care at Forest Hills of DC.
